

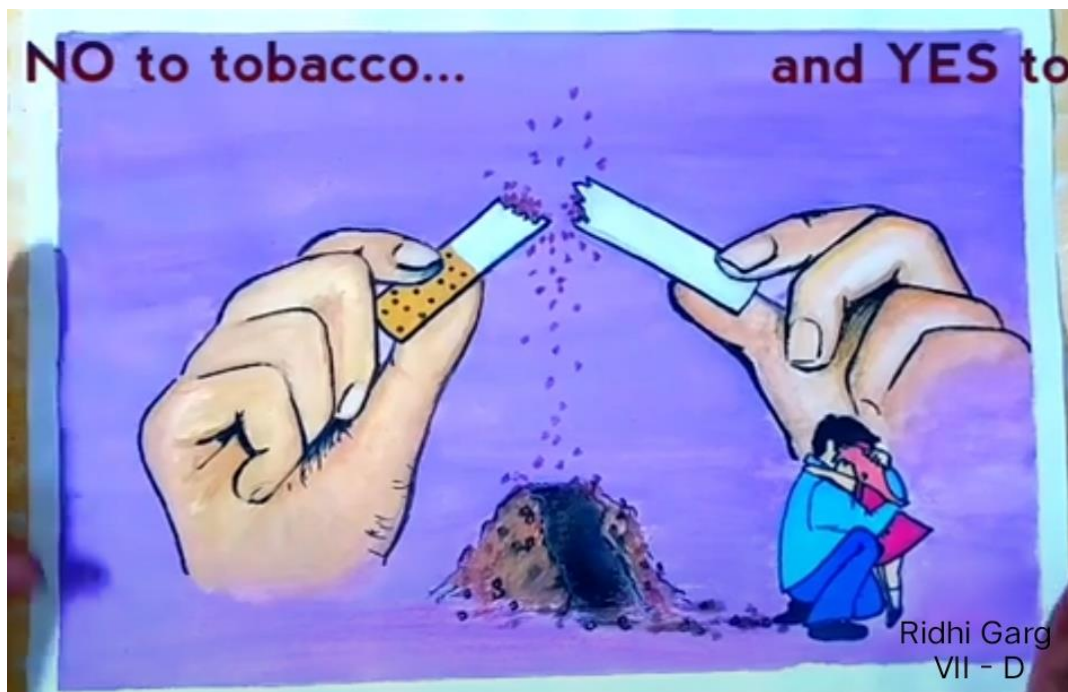

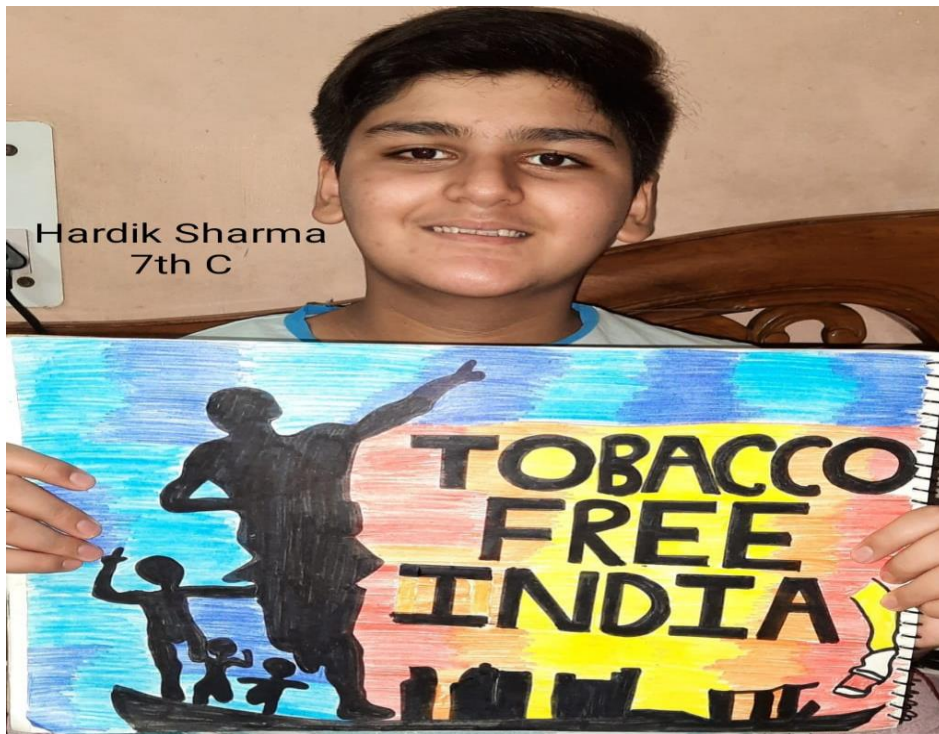
## **A Report on World No Tobacco Day**
