## Prevention and Control of Vector Borne Diseases (Dengue, Chikungunya & Malaria).

In view of early onset of Monsoon this year and water logging in Delhi, there are chances of significant increase in the number of dengue cases this year. Therefore, all necessary preventive measures are required to be implemented at the earliest.

Since, Aedes aegypti mosquito, the vector for the dengue virus, is generally active during day time and commonly bites on ankles and elbows and the fact that the incidence of acute dengue fever is higher in children. Hence the clothing worn by school going children should be such that both their upper and lower limbs are covered and unexposed.

- 1. Distribute that Dengue Homework card (DHC) to each and every student of the school.
- 2. Ensure that Dengue Homework Card (DHC) cards should be checked and signed by the class teacher/ nodal teacher on a weekly basis. The same may be discussed with parent at the time of PTM.
- 3. The students are allowed to wear uniform comprising of full sleeves shirts & trouser till November, 2023
